- Submit your application and apply for free — Visit educoglobal.com/spu
- Scan original academic records and email to us
- Send us official results of an English proficiency test — We require a minimum score of 79 on the iBT (550 paper-based TOEFL), overall band score of 6.5 on the IELTS, 56 on the PTE Academic, or pre-level 1 on the Eiken.
- Optional — Interviews and letters of recommendation.

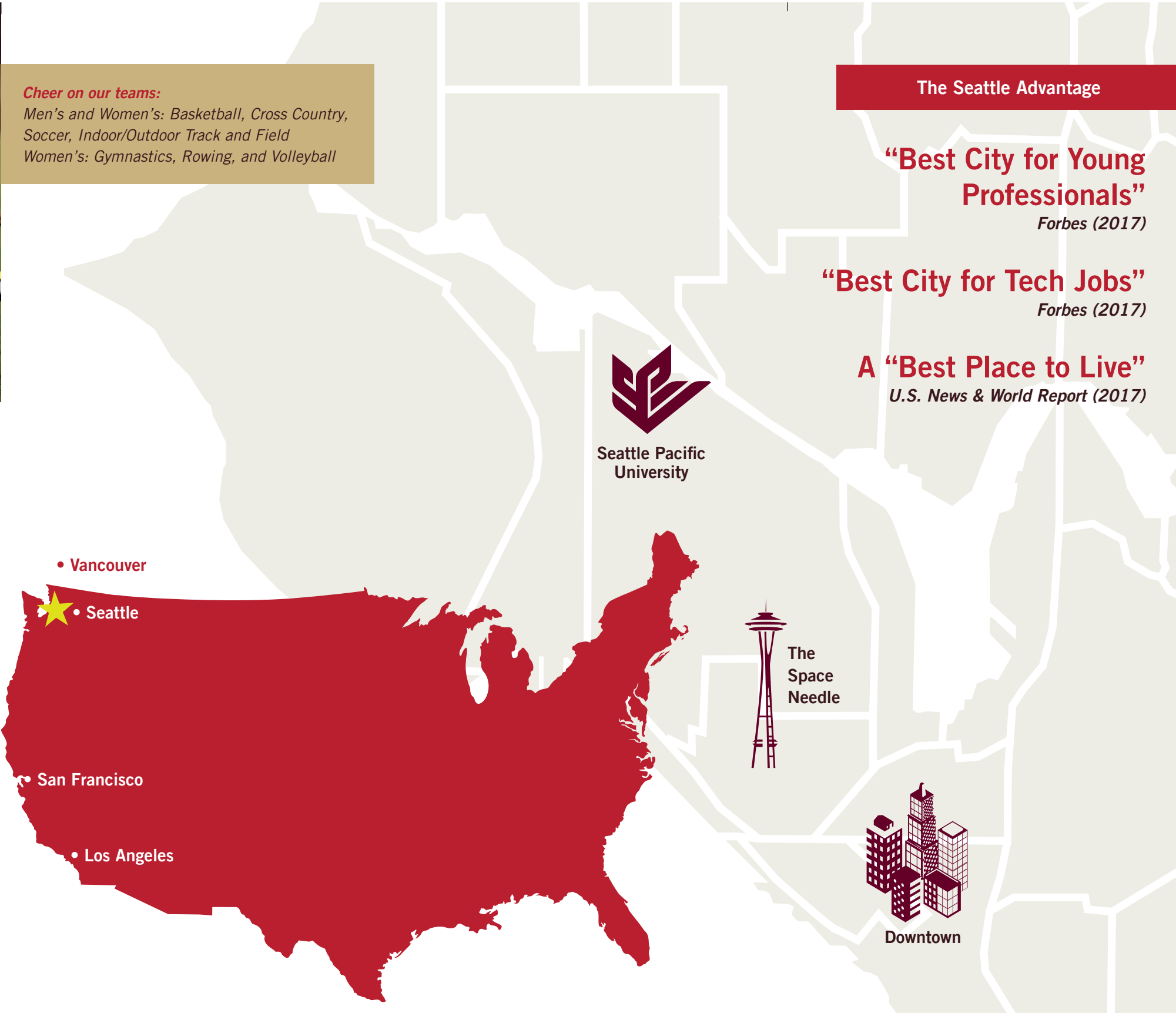
